Victorian Owners and Breeders Incentive Scheme (VOBIS)



All Super VOBIS-nominated horses can be upgraded to VOBIS Gold, with the full VOBIS scheme offering more than \$24 million in prize money and bonuses across 840 Super VOBIS races and 250 VOBIS Gold bonus races.

Queensland Thoroughbred Incentive Scheme (QTIS)
